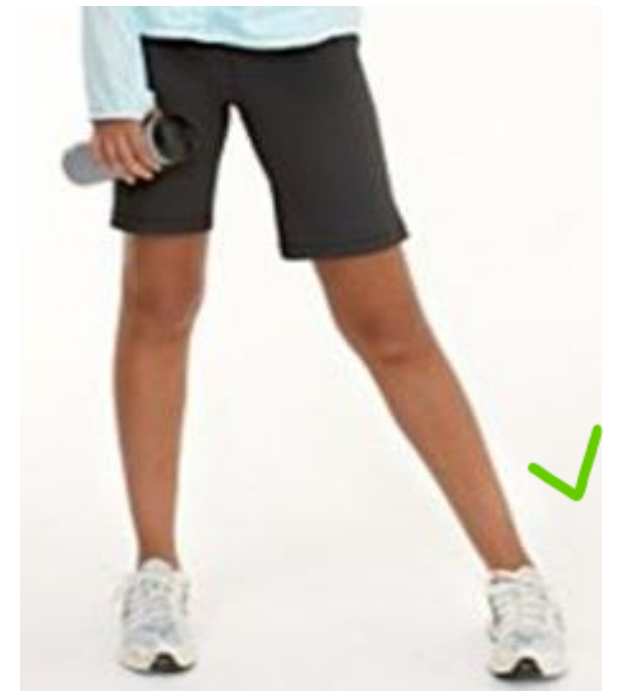

Dress Code

- Clothes worn to school must be clean, in good order, modest and appropriate for daily school life.
- There should be no offensive slogans or pictures on clothing/bags etc.
- Underwear should not be visible and clothing not transparent.
- Torn, ripped and very tight clothing are not appropriate.
- Footwear should be flat or with small heels only, it must be appropriate and not pose a safety hazard.
- Shorts, if worn, must come to mid-thigh.
- If wearing tight fitting shorts, they must be worn with a long loose top.
- If wearing a tight top, this must be worn with loose bottoms.
- No tight outfits, suitable for gym workouts are to be worn in school.
- Skirts and dresses should be of mid-thigh length and suitable for school. Shorts must be worn underneath, if exposure of underwear is a possibility.
- Low-cut tops and tops that expose the midriff are not allowed as part of the dress code.
- Outdoor coats are not be worn in class. Only light tracksuit jackets or hoodies are acceptable.
- Not hats or hoods are permitted to be up in class, with the exception of the following; (It is accepted by the school community that some students, due to sensory issues, may need to wear a hoodie up, or a hat in class. This is permitted, for these students only, however, full faces must be visible to staff).
- Hoodies or hats, are not to be worn around the school, going to and from classes or in the community space (unless by these students, mentioned above, who have permission).

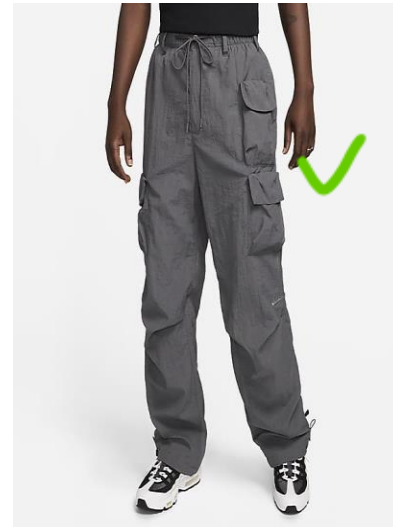
- Shorts, if worn, must come to mid-thigh see example below



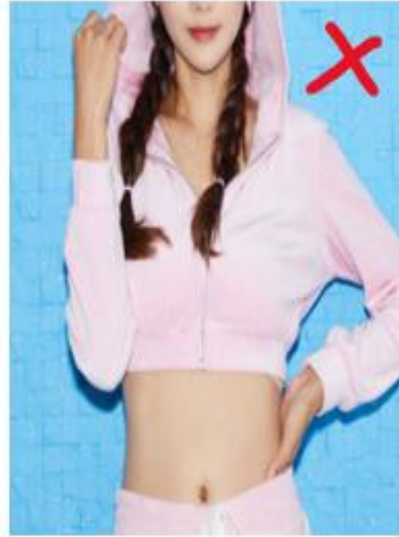
- If wearing tight fitting shorts or leggings, they must be worn with a long loose top.



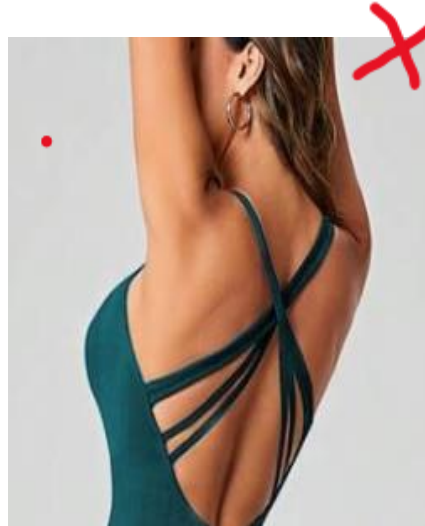
If wearing a tight top, this must be worn with loose bottoms.



Crop tops are not permitted.



Tight outfits for gym workouts are not to be worn in school. Long false nails cannot be worn in school.



No underwear to be on display.



Outdoor coats not permitted in class or around the corridors. Unless going outside or returning after breaks. Otherwise, they must be stored in lockers.



Appropriate PE clothing and shoes

- Only light soled are permitted for PE.
- PE areas will be: General Purpose space in the school and the Liam Rodgers Sports Hall.
- No Ugg boots, sandals, crocs etc are suitable for PE.
- If students do not have the correct footwear, they will not be permitted to play sport as they damage the specialist flooring.
